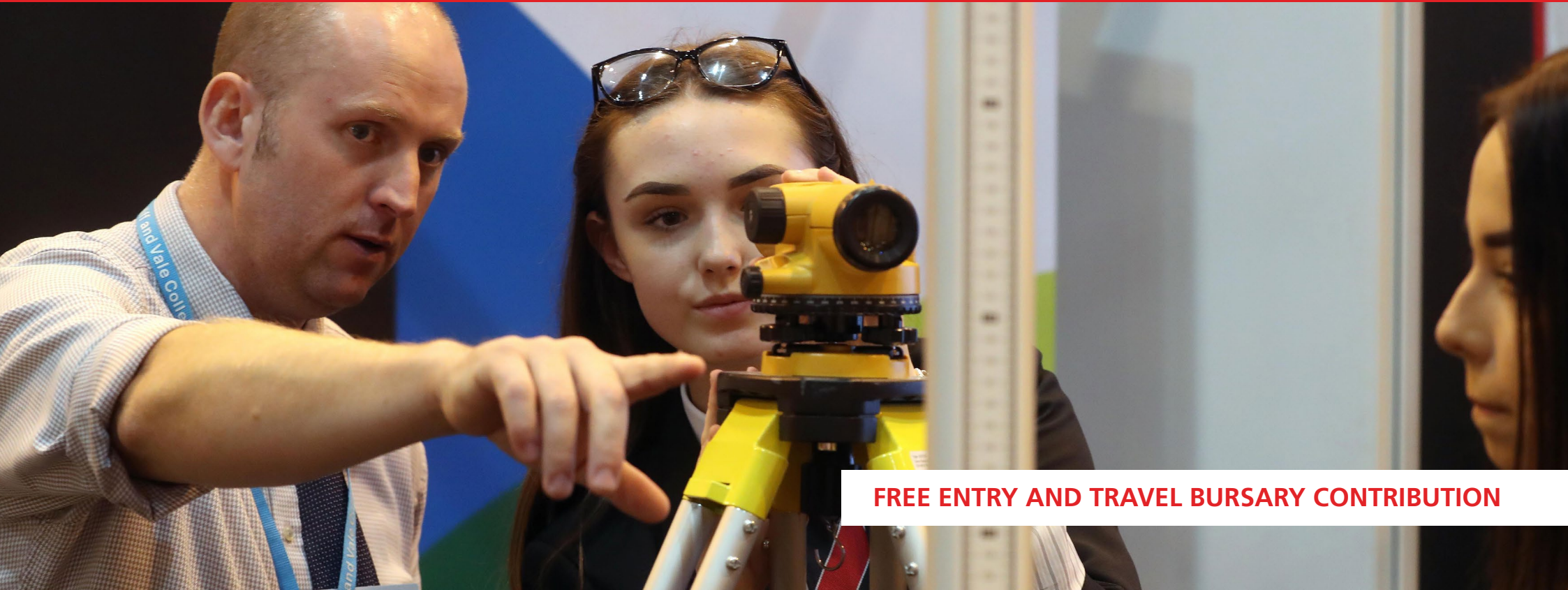

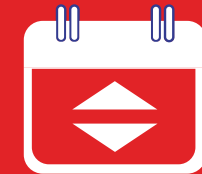
## WHAT IS SKILLSCYMRU?

# WHY VISIT SKILLSCYMRU?

SkillsCymru is Wales' largest series of skills, careers and apprenticeship exhibitions. The events provide 14-24 year olds, their teachers, career leaders and their parents and families the opportunity to experience the jobs of the future all in one place. The interactivity of the event allows young people to try new skills and make the connection between those skills and what they could potentially do as a career.

We recommend schools, colleges and sixth forms bring students in Years 10, 11, 12 and 13. Other visitors include undergraduates, recent graduates, young adults, NEETs, parents, carers, teachers and career leaders.

SkillsCymru is suitable for young people of all abilities and ambitions whether they are looking for a job or an apprenticeship, further or higher education, work placements or advice and guidance from specialists.

## Reasons to attend

- Help ensure that your students have meaningful encounters with employers, further and higher education providers and training providers all under one roof.
- Provide your students with access to a diverse range of career opportunities, hands-on activities, demonstrations, the chance to learn employability skills and face-to-face interactions with career professionals and industry experts.

# HOW TO BOOK YOUR GROUP VISIT

## STEP 1: DECIDE HOW MANY STUDENTS TO BRING

There is no limit to the number of students you bring, and we encourage large group bookings (even whole year groups) to ensure as many students as possible benefit from visiting SkillsCymru.

## STEP 2: SELECT THE BEST DATE AND TIME

At both our Llandudno and Cardiff event we have a dedicated evening that parents and carers can attend with their children to learn about future careers. We send out invitations to parents and carers in the local area for these evenings and they perfectly compliment the open days that students attend as part of a group.

A two-hour timeslot for your group visit will be allocated at a time best suited to your needs, however timeslots are reserved on a first come first served basis so please ensure you book early to avoid disappointment.
